

DMU Policy on COVID-19, Vaccinations, and Masks

As of May 28, 2021, fully vaccinated individuals do not need to wear a mask on the Divine Mercy University campus. The CDC recommends that unvaccinated individuals wear a mask. To respect individual privacy, there is no verification of vaccination status. Those without masks are not restricted from entering the building and a temperature check is not required to enter the building.

We recommend that all individuals associated with the University follow the CDC's guidelines for isolation, quarantine, and testing if you have been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19, have COVID-19 symptoms, or become infected with COVID-19. Also, please continue to refer to the DMU website for Coronavirus updates and additional changes to DMU operations as they occur.

Divine Mercy University does not have an on-campus health center and cannot provide vaccinations or verifications of vaccinations.

Since DMU has no COVID-19 vaccination requirement, students, staff and faculty who choose not to be vaccinated for religious or medical reasons are in fact exempt from being vaccinated by Divine Mercy University.
